⁴²⁷So then, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. ²⁸Everyone ought to examine themselves before they eat of the bread and drink from the cup. ²⁹ For those who eat and drink without discerning the body of Christ eat and drink judgment on themselves. ³⁰That is why many among you are weak and sick, and a number of you have fallen asleep. ³¹But if we were more discerning with regard to ourselves, we would not come under such judgment. ³²Nevertheless, when we are judged in this way by the Lord, we are being disciplined so that we will not be finally condemned with the world." I Corinthians 11:27f.

After reading this passage from St. Paul, can anyone dispute our practice of confirmation and closed communion? But they certainly do! But what I want to focus on is not that doctrine, but on what St. Paul attaches at the end of this admonition. Those words in verse 32 are very instructive for any Christian.

Why do we suffer? I would be lying if I said that I could explain all the things that cause us pain. And pain is not just restricted to how our bodies feel. Pain can take many forms for there are many ways that the Lord can discipline us. In our lives we must learn many things. And discipline, which very often involves painful experiences, is the way most, if not all, of us learn.

When we were children, we had to be taught lessons that were intended to keep us safe, if not just alive. The world can be a dangerous place and parents are the ones God appoints to teach children. What can be said of the physical also applies to the spiritual. Parents are the primary teachers who must discipline children so they will learn the spiritual lessons necessary to be kept safe in a world full of the devil's works. But who is appointed to teach these hard spiritual lessons when we reach adulthood? We are no longer under the care of our parents. Perhaps this is why young adults who leave parents to make their way in the world fall into sin and other great shame and vice. Like the prodigal son, young people often must find out the hard way what the world is like outside of the church.

There must be discipline and, in those cases, God Himself is the instructor to lead us to our senses. This is a process, the Lord's discipline, that never ends for us until we close our eyes in death. God Himself chooses the discipline we need and applies it.

And a good thing too! We can rejoice in the Lord's discipline. That work, alien as it is to what most people would call good, is a holy thing for us Christians. Through this discipline, God our loving Father, keeps us close by His side if we do not grow tired and frustrated as many do when put through fire. We needn't be anxious that we suffer. We, as God's children, know it is for our good, even if we don't understand the need that God sees.

Contrast that with the world. The world tells us to run from pain and suffering. The world chides us, much like the unbelievers at the foot of the cross. How could a loving God do such things to His people. He can't care for you if He is willing to make you suffer such pain and misery.

But which is better, to live in comfort and pleasure and die in sin, or to suffer and inherit eternal life? Doesn't seem like much of a choice to me. Hard as discipline may be, Lord, give that to me so that I too may inherit eternal life, as St. Paul writes. May you too rejoice in the Lord's discipline and sit with Him and His saints in eternal life. To Jesus be the glory forever and ever. Amen.
