#### I thank the Lord for you.

"I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy, because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now. I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ." Philippians 1:3-6. These words were spoken by Paul to the church at Philippi. I thank God for you all because of the partnership we have in the gospel. We know that the word "Gospel" comes from the Greek word "Euangelion," which means good news. The good news is that Jesus died and rose for the entire world. As Christians, we receive Christ through His Word, Holy Baptism and the Lord's Supper. I look forward to seeing how we at Grace Lutheran Church and School will partner in the gospel. I thank Christ for all He has done for us. I thank Christ for His gifts, and you are one of them. Christ has begun a good work in us. The Lord be with you.
